The Equity Portal will become one of the principal ways LHJs and other stakeholders engage with OHE through technical assistance, award management, resource sharing, and virtual forums

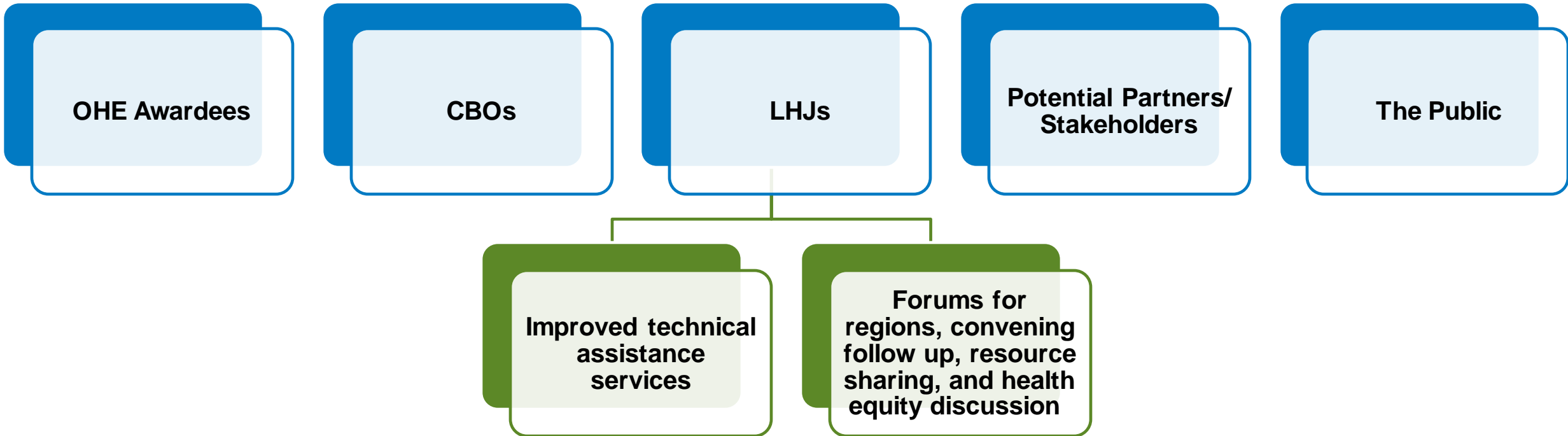
